This is in response to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request (MSPB-OCB-2014-000252) dated September 08, 2013. You are requesting the FY 2012, 2011, 2010, and 2009 end-of-year reports, to the Board Chairman or her designee, summarizing the MSPB IG Hotline and investigative activity for the year. A description of this report is available in Section 17.B. of MSPB Order 1095 (issued on July 12, 2005). I also request the FY 2012, 2011, 2010, and 2009 reports to Congress required under Section 8G(h)(2) of the Inspector General Act of 1978, as amended. Your request has been processed in accordance with the Merit Systems Protection Board (MSPB) regulation at 5 CFR Part 1204 that implements the FOIA.

We have conducted a thorough search of our records and found records responsive to your request. No IG reports were completed because no IG investigations were conducted between 2009 – 2012. Also, no IG reports were sent to Congress between 2009 - 2012. Therefore, we are providing you with a no records response to your FOIA request.

Your appeal should be identified as a "FOIA Appeal" on both the letter and the envelope.
