This is in response to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request (MSPB-OCB-2014-000010) dated October 25, 2013. You requested the FY 2002-2008 end-of-year reports, to the Board Chairman or her designee, summarizing the MSPB IG Hotline and investigative activity for the year. A description of the report is available in Section 17.B. of MSPB Order 1095 (issued on July 12, 2005). You also requested the FY 2002-2008 reports to Congress required under Section 8G(h)(2) of the Inspector General Act of 1978, as amended. Your request has been processed in accordance with the Merit Systems Protection Board (MSPB) regulation at 5 CFR Part 1204 that implements the FOIA.

We have conducted a thorough search of our records and found no records responsive to your request. The Office of General Council, MSPB has not filed any IG reports for the time period between FY 2002-2008. Therefore, we are sending you a no records response.
